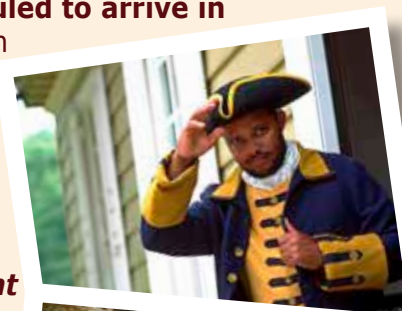

## Busch Gardens

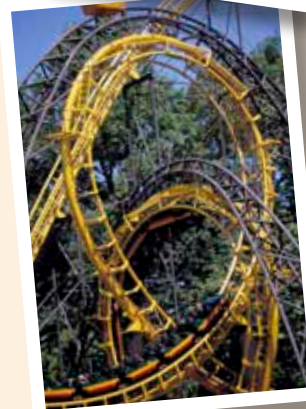
Busch Gardens is a one of a kind amusement park located in the heart of Williamsburg's Historic Triangle. Heart stopping rides and attractions are set to an authentic European theme with breathtaking landscaping that has earned the park the award of America's Most Beautiful Theme Park for more than 20 consecutive years.

At Busch Gardens Williamsburg there is fun for the entire family with more than **50 thrilling rides and attractions, Broadway style shows, mouth-watering cuisine, and of course those beautiful animals** that Busch Gardens has always been known for.

If you are traveling with little ones look for the **"kid-siderate"** designation to let you know those areas especially designed for kids including Sesame Street Forest of Fun and Land of the Dragons. Kids can spend hours on mini rides and coasters like Grover's Alpine Express and Elmo's Spire or splashing in water fountains and climbing through tree houses.

State of the art technology makes Busch Gardens coasters some of the most exciting around. Be sure to try **Alpengeist and Apollo's Chariot both of which have been named among the top ten steel coasters in the world**, or tame the mighty Griffon. With speeds over 75mph, Griffon lifts riders more than 205 feet in the air and simply hangs for several seconds before taking the 90 degree drop that sends you soaring.

Animal preservation has always been a part of the Busch Gardens mission. Animal shows like Pet Shenanigans with hilarious animal outtakes are complimented by awe inspiring animal exhibits including the magnificent Clydesdale horses in Highland Stables, stunning Bald Eagles on Eagle Ridge and get a glimpse into the life of wolves at Wolf Haven.



There are now several Busch Gardens events throughout the year to make your visit even more special. **Visit in late spring and early summer for the Food and Wine festival or in the summer for the Summer Concert series and 4th of July Fireworks!**

The change of seasons also brings a transformation to the park. In late September and October the bravest of souls will want to visit for Howl-O-Scream the annual spook-tacular event that brings haunted houses and spine tingling scares around every corner.

# Colonial Williamsburg's Historic Area

is an 18th-century town restored to the time this it was Britain's largest colony of the new world. It is truly an outdoor living museum with over 500 public buildings, homes, stores, taverns and some of the most beautiful gardens that one can experience. Upon visiting Colonial Williamsburg's Historic Area you will find tradesmen demonstrating over 30 historic trades and domestic crafts and character actors recreating history.

Now you can be a part of the story. In the Colonial Williamsburg Revolutionary City, live action takes place each day (weather permitting) when the east end of the Historic Area near the Capitol Building is transformed into a street theater. Here the events of the revolution that gave birth to a nation play out in everyday life. Take it a step further and participate in the new Rev Quest, an undercover adventure that leads you throughout the historic area as your search for clues to solve a mystery.

Colonial Williamsburg also offers a variety of dining options including historical taverns with traditional fare of the time. Enjoy the upscale dining of Kings Arms or perhaps



a casual dinner at Chownings and enjoy the age old tradition of Gambols (popular sing alongs and gaming for those of you living in the 21st Century). If the fine dining of today is more your style you will find Merchant's Square at the end of Duke of Gloucester Street where you will find exquisite shopping and dining options.

# Water Country USA

Your family is in for a sun splash' day of fun and excitement at the Mid-Atlantic's largest water park. This 50's and 50's themed water park has more than 40 acres of rides and attractions including pools, lazy rivers, water rides and state of the art rides.

Young and old will have a blast on attractions like "Rock 'n' Roll Island," a popular ride with body slides, lazy river and a 9,000-square-foot pool. Take a "cruise" down the Hubba Hubba Highway, Water Country USA's radical river adventure. Still looking for more? Drop in on Vanish Point or try Colossal Curl, a high flying mega slide that gives riders a feeling of weightlessness as they soar above the park.

### Williamsburg Winery

## Golfing

## Jamestown

It was May 13, 1607 when 104 Englishmen had traveled across the Atlantic Ocean, dropped anchor at what is now Jamestown, Virginia and began America's first permanent English colony.

Discover the world of Pocahontas in the Powhatan Indian village. In this recreated village learn how Pocahontas' people lived. In visiting Powhatan houses,

called yehakins, you will be able to weave marsh grass into ropes, create a dugout canoe and grind corn. Come aboard the replicas of the Susan Constant, Godspeed and Discovery. There you will get a sense of how the colonists felt and lived as they crossed the Atlantic.



## Yorktown

Yorktown is where George Washington's army surrounded and besieged General Charles Lord Cornwallis' British forces. On October 17, Lord Cornwallis asked for a cease fire. It was then on October 19 that he and his army marched out to an open field stacked their weapons and surrendered.
